- P Permit will be required from the Marine Parks Authority. Any activities that are inconsistent with marine park zoning will not be permitted in that particular zone.
- 1 Requires fishing licence / permit.
- 2 Restrictions within the Fisheries Management Act 1994 apply and are subject to provisions of the zoning plan.
- Some species are protected in Jervis Bay Marine Park and cannot be taken. See Table 1 overleaf for a list of protected species.
- 2 Spearfishing is prohibited in all creeks, the Hyams Beach Habitat Protection Zone and inside Honeymoon Bay.
- 3 Recreational nets permitted are dip/scoop/push/scissor net (prawns), or hoop/lift net.
- 4 Anchoring is restricted to designated anchoring areas in some sanctuary zones, see map above. Anchoring is allowed in any zone in an emergency where necessary to protect life or property.
- 5 Is limited to a specific area. The number of permits is strictly controlled and permits are non-transferable.

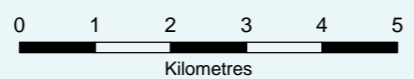
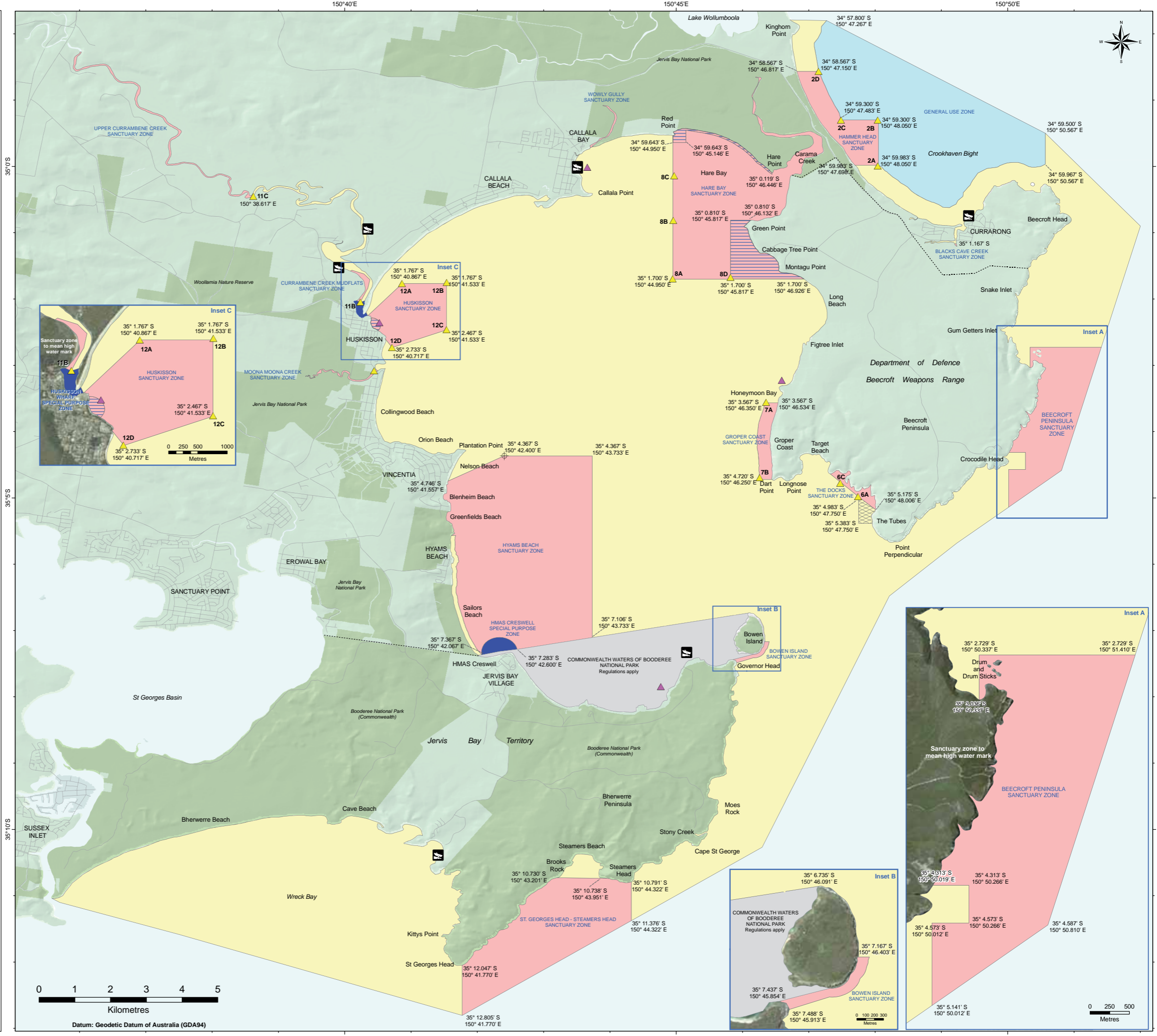
A summary of activities permitted and restrictions which apply are detailed above. Refer to the Marine Parks (Zoning Plans) Regulation 1999.
